5	Holiday Farm	OR-WIF	Hessel	Mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair.
6	Archie Creek	OR-UPF	Shindelar	Mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair.
7	Thielsen	OR-UPF	Shindelar	Mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair.
