1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Bootleg	OR-FWF	Allen, Hessel, & Lawson	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Significant fire runs to the east.
3	Grandview	OR-955S	Cline	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Critical day for line construction on the SE perimeter.
4	Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Goff	Evacuation levels remain. Successful burnout operations continue.
5	Cedar Creek, Varden, & Delancy	WA-OWF	Stock	Developing strategies and tactics. Assessing evacuation plans.
6	Lick Creek	WA-SES	Johnson	Continued line construction and burnout.
7	Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Loomis	Direct and indirect line construction.
