• Continue to staff new emerging incidents with limited resource capability, particularly recently deployed IMTs.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

Priority	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Bootleg	OR-FWF	Allen, Hessel, & Lawson	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Log fire increased complexity.
3	Grandview	OR-955S	Cline	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Developing structure triage, building, and reinforcing line SE flank.
4	Chuweah Creek Fire	WA-COA	Dimke	Level 3 evacuations, Highway 21 corridor impacted.
5	Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Goff	Evacuation levels remain. Successful burnout operations continue. Expanded forest closures.
6	Bruler	OR-WIF	Gales	Direct and indirect line construction. Heavy fuels, deep duff.
7	Cedar Creek, Varden, & Delancy	WA-OWF	Stock	Level 2 evacuations. All incidents are full suppression.
8	Lick Creek	WA-SES	Johnson	Continued line construction and burnout.
9	Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Loomis	Direct and indirect line construction.
