Strategic Intent

- Continue to staff new emerging incidents with limited resource capability, especially recently deployed IMTs.
- Work with IMTs to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

<u>Priority</u>	Fire	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Bootleg/Log	OR-FWF	Allen, Hessel	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Log fire growth to the west. Prepping critical east flank.
3	Cedar Creek/Delancy	WA-OWF	Stock	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. IMT assuming command of Cub Creek 2.
4	Chuweah Creek Fire	WA-COA	Dimke	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations (some residents refusing to leave), Highway 21 corridor impacted.
5	Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Loomis	Level 1 evacuations. Fire growth to the east threatening lookout and recreation residences.
6	Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Goff	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Highway 138 has reopened.
7	Summit Trail	WA-COA	Dalrymple	Direct line construction in progress. Securing Keno and Klondike fires.

8	Red Apple	WA-SES	McGowan	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Securing northern flank. Containment at 51%.
9	Lick Creek	OR-UMF	Johnson	Level 1 and 2 evacuations in place. Supporting Elbow Creek. Critical burnout operations complete.
10	Bruler	OR-WIF	Gales	Line construction completed. Hose lay in place and mop-up continues.
11	Grandview	OR-955S	Howard	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place (number of affected structures reduced). Mop-up continues. Sending resources to support Elbow Creek.
12	Darlene	OR-PRD	Sheldon	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. All level 3 evacuations dropped. TOC to local unit 7/19/21.
