- Work with IMTs to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.

1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Bootleg/Log	OR-FWF	Allen, Hessel	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Log fire growth to the west. Prepping critical east flank.
3	Cedar Creek/Delancy	WA-OWF	Stock	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. IMT assumed command of Cub Creek 2 7/18.
4	Summit Trail	WA-COA	Dalrymple	Level 1 evacuations. High value timber threatened. Direct line construction in progress. Keno and Klondike fires contained.
5	Chuweah Creek Fire	WA-COA	Dimke	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Fire is backing down toward Highway 21.
6	Elbow Creek	OR-UMF	Smith	Level 3 evacuations. IMT1 assumed command 7/18, assessing situation.
7	Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Loomis	Level 1 evacuations. Fire growth to the east threatening lookout and recreation residences.

11	Red Apple	WA-SES	McGowan	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Securing northern flank. Containment at 80%.
12	Grandview	OR-955S	Howard	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place (number of affected structures reduced). Mop-up continues. TOC 7/22 to local unit.
13	Darlene	OR-PRD	Sheldon	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. TOC to local unit 7/19/21.
