## **Strategic Intent**

- Prepare to staff new large incidents based on weather and fuel conditions.
- Work with IMTs to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.

## **PNW Incident Priorities** (set daily):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Bootleg/Log	OR-FWF	Allen, Hessel	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Likely to add more structures to evac levels. Log and Bootleg merged.
3	Cedar Creek/Delancy	WA-OWF	Stock	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Likely to add more structures to evac levels.
4	Summit Trail	WA-COA	Dalrymple	Level 1 evacuations. High value timber threatened.
5	Chuweah Creek Fire	WA-COA	Dimke	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Fire is backing down toward Highway 21. Drone intrusion in TFR.
6	Elbow Creek	OR-UMF	Smith	Level 3 evacuations. Assessing structures. Movement is primarily SW.
7	Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Loomis	Level 1 evacuations. Fire growth to the east threatening lookout and recreation residences.
8	Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Goff	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. HWY 138 safety concerns (speed). Critical area on SE flank.

9	Lick Creek	OR-UMF	Johnson	Level 1 and 2 evacuations (evaluate today and likely reduce). TOC Green Ridge @ 0600 7/20 (Tuesday).
10	Bruler	OR-WIF	Gales	Hose lay in place and mop-up continues. Strengthening lines, hazard tree removal.
11	Grandview	OR-955S	Howard	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place (likely to reduce today). Mop-up continues. TOC 7/22 to local unit.
12	Red Apple	WA-SES	McGowan	Level 1 and 2 evacuations (evaluate and likely to reduce today). TOC to local unit @ 1800 7/20 (Tuesday).
