- Prepare to staff new large incidents based on weather and fuel conditions.
- Work with IMTs to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

Priority	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Cedar Creek/Delancy	WA-OWF	Stock	Level 1, 2 and 3 evacuations. Finger to east side of Virginian Ridge is problematic.
3	Cub Creek 2	WA-NES	McGowan	Level 1, 2 and 3 evacuations. Steady growth to the north continues.
4	Bootleg	OR-FWF	Allen, Hessel	Level 1, 2 and 3 evacuations. Moderate spread N, NE and E toward Summer Lake.
5	Chuweah Creek Fire	WA-COA	Dimke	All evacuations lowered to level 1. Progress continues securing east flank.
6	Summit Trail	WA-COA	Dalrymple	Level 1 evacuations. Important cultural sites threatened. Growth continues in Beaver Dam Creek drainage to the east. Fire crossed Lynx Creek Road on N flank.
7	Elbow Creek	OR-UMF	Smith	Evacuation notices eliminated. Line constructed to Grande Ronde River, working to secure and hold.

9	Jack	OR-UPF	Lawson	Level 1 evacuations. Increased activity on interior island in north flank. SE corner continues to be problematic.
10	Bruler	OR-WIF	Gales	Hoselay in place and mop-up continues. Strengthening lines, hazard tree removal. TOC to IMT3 on Wednesday 7/28.
