- Realign resources on existing incidents as critical objectives are met or critical needs arise.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Cedar Creek/Delancy	WA-OWF	Stock	Level 1, 2 and 3 evacuations (added structures to level 3). Critical firing operations in SE corner to contain movement toward Winthrop.
3	Cub Creek 2	WA-NES	McGowan	Level 1, 2 and 3 evacuations. Critical area in Pebble and Boulder Creek to secure eastern flank.
4	Bootleg	OR-FWF	Allen, Hessel	Level 2 and 3 evacuations. Working on control lines in NW corner and N flank. Strengthening lines on NE flank.
5	Summit Trail	WA-COA	Dalrymple	Level 1 evacuations. Important cultural sites threatened. Significant growth to the north. Working critical area in Beaver Dam drainage.
6	Elbow Creek	OR-UMF	Smith	Holding line constructed to Grande Ronde River. Spots from interior burnout in NW corner, heavy mop-up.
7	Chuweah Creek Fire	WA-COA	Dimke	All evacuation levels have been dropped. Progress continues securing east flank.
8	Sherwood	WA-SPA	Sheldon	Level 2 and 3 evacuations. Working critical areas on N and E flanks.

9	Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Lawson	Level 1 evacuations. SE corner burned to primary control line with slops over line.
10	Lick Creek/Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Johnson	Level 1 evacuations. Working west flank on Green Ridge to contain fire spread over Meadow Creek.
11	Bruler	OR-WIF	Gales	Hoselay in place and mop-up continues. Strengthening lines, hazard tree removal. TOC to IMT3 on Wednesday 7/28.
