Strategic Intent

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT 1/2 deployments.
- Realign resources on existing incidents as critical objectives are met or critical needs arise.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-OWF	Kuo	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Active on west and southwest flanks. Estimated 3,000 to 5,000 acres of growth.
3	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Goff	Consists of 12 new lightning fires. Evaluating evacuation levels.
4	Jack Fire/ Rough Patch Complex	OR-UPF	Lawson	Level 1 evacuations. Added Rough Patch Complex (6 fires). Firing along primary lines. Going direct in Twin Lakes area.
5	Bootleg	OR-FWF	McDonald	Level 2 and 3 evacuations. Active on north end. Assisted with initial attack.
6	Cub Creek 2	WA-NES	Bales	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations (Lowered some level 3 and 2 in south end). Prioritizing east flank and critical area in Pebble and Boulder Creek.

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
7	Summit Trail/ Chuweah Creek	WA-COA	Loomis	Level 1 evacuations. Important cultural sites threatened. Firing operations in Sitdown Creek.
8	Lick Creek/ Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Nobles	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Active fire on southeast, south, and southwest flanks. Spot fire to the southwest.
9	Sherwood	WA-SPA	Sheldon	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Mop-up and securing entire perimeter.
10	Elbow Creek	OR-UMF	Smith	Mop-up and securing lines.
