3	Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-OWF	Kuo	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Working with county to reduce evacuation levels and to reopen Highway 20.
4	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Gales	Initial attack on 19 new fires yesterday. Evaluating and prioritizing resource needs.
5	Summit Trail/ Chuweah Creek	WA-COA	Loomis	Level 1 evacuations. Direct and indirect line being established.
6	Bootleg	OR-FWF	McDonald	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Continued progress on control lines.
7	Lick Creek/ Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Nobles	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Priority is the west and south flanks of the fire. Burnout operations continue.
8	Cub Creek 2	WA-NES	Bales	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Mopping up and securing lines.
