3	Skyline Ridge Complex	OR-732S	Hessel	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. 15 active fires in complex.
4	Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-OWF	Kuo	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Working with county to reduce evacuation levels and to reopen Highway 20.
5	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Gales	Reduced Jack Fire containment. Still finding new fires.
6	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Goff	Level 3 evacuations. Added closures to Salmon Creek area.
7	Summit Trail/ Chuweah Creek	WA-COA	Loomis	Level 1 evacuations. Supporting initial attack and sending surge of resources to Whitmore Fire.
