## **PNW Incident Priorities** (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Whitmore/ Hamilton	WA-COA	Dimke	Level 2 and 3 evacuations. Timber values being impacted.
3	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Stock	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Continuing to assess fires in the complex and developing strategy.
4	Skyline Ridge Complex	OR-732S	Hessel	Level 1 evacuations. Multiple fires in the complex. Poole Creek priority fire.
5	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Gales	Jack Fire growing to west. Additional fires added to complex.
6	Summit Trail/ Chuweah Creek	WA-COA	Loomis	Level 1 evacuations on Summit Trail. Supporting initial attack and sending surge of resources to Whitmore Fire.
7	Lick Creek/ Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Nobles	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Priority is the north and northwest flanks of the fire.

8	Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-OWF	Kuo	Level 2 and 3 evacuations. Working with county to reduce evacuation levels and reopen highway 20.
9	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Goff	Level 3 evacuations. Shadow day with PNW 3.
10	Cub Creek 2	WA-NES	Bales	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Mopping up and securing lines around homes. Supporting initial attack.
11	Bootleg	OR-FWF	Allen	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Yainax and Walrus added to delegation. PNW 2 assumed command at 0600.
