4	Skyline Ridge Complex	OR-732S	Hessel	Level 1 evacuations. Multiple fires in the complex. Prioritizing objectives for O'Shea and Sweat Creek fires.
5	Bootleg	OR-FWF	Allen	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Future Planning for organizational needs.
6	Lick Creek/ Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Nobles	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Priority is the north and northwest flanks. TOC 8/8 @ 0600 RM Team Black Hagan.
7	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Gales	Jack fire growing to the west. Three fires to the south being evaluated.
