- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT 1/2 deployments.
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Whitmore	WA- COA	Dimke	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Area closures, rapid fire growth in all directions.
3	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Stock	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Focus is on incidents 446 and 495.
4	Skyline Ridge Complex	OR-732S	Hessel	Level 1 evacuations. Multiple fires in the complex. Prioritizing Poole Creek.
5	Summit Trail/ Chuweah Creek	WA- COA	Loomis	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Added Upper Lime Creek fire. Supporting initial attack.
6	Lick Creek/ Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Hagan	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. RM Team Black (Hagan) assumed command @ 0600.
7	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Gales	41 total incidents in complex. Direct and indirect line construction continues.

8	Cub Creek 2	WA-NES	Bales	Level 1, 2 and 3 evacuations. Assumed command of Muckamuck fire.
9	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Johnson	Level 3 evacuations. Assumed command of Knoll fire.
10	Bootleg	OR-FWF	Allen	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Future planning for organizational needs ongoing. Heavy demob.
11	Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA- OWF	Kuo	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Working with county to reduce evacuation levels and to reopen Highway 20. Demob in progress
12	Walker Creek	WA-NES	Winfield	Information limited to 209.
