- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed. •
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives. •

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Whitmore	WA-COA	Schindelar	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Area closures.
3	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Stock	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Transitioning small fires to mop-up and patrol.
4	Skyline Ridge Complex	OR-732S	Hessel	Level 1 evacuations. No growth on any fires, except Poole Creek.
5	Summit Trail/ Chuweah Creek	WA-COA	Loomis	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Supporting initial attack. Fires received some precipitation.
6	Walker Creek	WA-NES	Winfield	Level 3 evacuations. Direct and indirect line constructions. Area closures.
7	Black Butte	OR-MAF	Goff	Assumed command at 0600 today.

8	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Gales	Direct and indirect line construction continues. Expanded Jack Fire area closures.
9	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Johnson	Level 1 and 3 evacuations. Kwis is the priority fire.
10	Cub Creek 2	WA-NES	Bales	Level 1 and 3 evacuations. Direct line construction on Muckamuck Fire.
11	Lick Creek/ Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Hagan	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Building and securing line.
12	Schneider Springs/Windy Pass	WA-OWF	L. Minton	Information limited to 209
13	Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-OWF	Kuo	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Working with county to reduce evacuation levels. Soft reopening of Highway 20.
14	Bootleg	OR-FWF	Allen	Eliminating all evacuation levels.
