- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.
- Area Command has been mobilized to assist in coordinating long-term planning for incidents throughout the geographic area.

1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Twentyfive Mile	WA-OWF	Sinclair	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Beginning firing operations on the southeast and northeast corners. Supporting initial attack.
3	Schneider Springs	WA-OWF	Allen	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations (dropped some level 3 and level 2). Beginning firing operations on the southeast flank.
4	Ford Corkscrew	WA-NES	Bernal	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Working direct and indirect control lines on the northern flank.
5	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire/Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	DeMasters	Level 2 evacuations. Firing operations continue across seven areas. Increased activity on the Smith fire; potential impact to residences.
6	Fox Complex	OR-FWF	Smith	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations (assessing evacuation levels today). Mop up the north flank. Planning TOC to local unit on 8/28.

7	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Gales	Level 1 and 3 evacuations. Focus is on firing operations on the north flank of Gales.
8	Walker Creek/ Chickadee	WA-NES	Haydon	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Making progress on direct control lines.
9	Summit Trail	WA-COA	Lawson	Level 1 evacuations. Going direct on north and east flanks.
10	Bulldog Mountain/ Mack Mountain	WA-COF	Loomis	Level 1 evacuations dropped on Bulldog Mountain. Working indirect control lines on both fires. Spot fires previously identified on Mack Mountain will be removed from mapping.
11	Cub Creek 2/ Muckamuck/ Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-NES	Minton	Level 1, 2 evacuations (all level 3 dropped). Completing line on the north flank of Muckamuck. Inserting T2IA crew on Cedar Creek.
12	Bull Complex	OR-MHF	Roide	Indirect control lines established. Evaluating future firing opportunities.
13	Lick Creek/ Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Hagan	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Green Ridge southern flank continues to burn into wilderness.
14	Black Butte	OR-MAF	Sheldon	Mop-up, secure, and patrol all flanks. TOC to local unit on 8/25.
