Strategic Intent

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT 1/2 deployments.
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.
- Area Command has been mobilized to assist in coordinating long-term planning for incidents throughout the geographic area.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

| <u>Priority</u> | <u>Fire</u> | <u>Unit</u> | <u>IC</u> | <u>Rationale</u> |

| 1 | Initial Attack | | | Initial attack is always the first priority. |
| 2 | Twentyfive Mile | WA-OWF | Sinclair | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations (some level 3 reduced to 2). Continuing indirect line construction the south and southwest flanks. |
| 3 | Ford Corkscrew | WA-NES | Bernal | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations (assessing evacuation levels today). Working direct and indirect control lines on the northern flank. |
| 4 | Devils Knob Complex | OR-UPF | Dolan | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Structure protection in Ash Creek Valley. Smith Fire is the primary focus. |
| 5 | Schneider Springs | WA-OWF | Allen | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Beginning firing operations on the southeast flank. |
| 6 | Middle Fork Complex | OR-WIF | Gales | Level 1 and 3 evacuations. Focus is on firing operations on the north flank of Gales. |

|-----------------|---|-------------|-----------|--|
| 7 | Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire | OR-UPF | DeMasters | Completing firing operations between Jack Fire and Buckhead. Working direct control lines on Near Minky. |
| 8 | Walker Creek/ Chickadee | WA-NES | Haydon | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Completing indirect line on Chickadee and firing operations planned. TOC with PNW Team 12 (Dimke) 8/26 at 0600. |
| 9 | Summit Trail | WA-COA | Lawson | Going direct on north and east flanks. |
| 10 | Fox Complex | OR-FWF | Smith | Mop up the north flank. TOC to local unit on 8/28. |
| 11 | Cub Creek 2/ Muckamuck/ Cedar Creek/ Delancy | WA-NES | Goff | Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Completing line on the north flank of Muckamuck. |
| 12 | Bull Complex | OR-MHF | Roide | Indirect control lines established. Evaluating future firing opportunities. |
| 13 | Bulldog Mountain/Mack Mountain | WA-COF | Loomis | Working indirect control lines on both fires. Assuming command of Summit Trail on 8/26 0700. |
| 14 | Lick Creek/Green Ridge | OR-UMF | Hagan | Level 1 and 2 evacuations (all level 3 reduced to 2). Green Ridge southern flank continues slow progression into wilderness. TOC to NW Team 8 (Stock) on 8/26 at 0600. |
