- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.
- Area Command has been mobilized to assist in coordinating long-term planning for incidents throughout the geographic area.

1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Twentyfive Mile	WA-OWF	Sinclair	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Continuing indirect line construction, the south and southwest flanks.
3	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Dolan	Level 2 evacuations. Structure protection in Ash Creek Valley. Smith Fire is the primary focus.
4	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Gales	Level 1 and 3 evacuations. Focus is on firing operations on the north flank of Gales.
5	Schneider Springs	WA-OWF	Allen	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the southeast flank.
6	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	DeMasters	Planning firing operations between Chaos and Little Bend Creek. Working direct control lines on Near Minky.
7	Ford Corkscrew	WA-NES	Bernal	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations (lowered some evacuation levels). Working direct control lines on the northern flank.

9	Bulldog Mountain/Mack Mountain/ Summit Trail	WA-COF	Loomis	Working indirect control lines on Bulldog and Mack Mountain. Working direct control lines on Summit Trail.
10	Cub Creek 2/ Muckamuck/ Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-NES	Goff	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Strengthening and mopping up lines on the north flank of Muckamuck.
11	Bull Complex	OR-MHF	Roide	Continuing firing operations on the south flank. Working indirect control lines.
12	Fox Complex	OR-FWF	Smith	Mop up the north flank. TOC to local unit on 8/28.
13	Lick Creek/Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Stock	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Green Ridge southern flank continues slow progression into wilderness.
