## **Strategic Intent**

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT 1/2 deployments.
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.
- Review and apply the Area Command recommendations as they fit the current/expected fire situation.

## PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Dolan	Level 2 evacuations. Scouting indirect options on the northeast corner of Smith. Continue firing operations on Smith and Big Hamlin.
3	Schneider Springs	WA-OWF	Allen	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations (evaluating level 3). Firing operations on the south flank along Bethel Ridge.
4	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Goicoechea	Firing operations on the north and south flanks of Chaos. Prepping containment lines north to the Bohemia Mine.
5	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Gales	Level 1 and 3 evacuations. Firing operations on northeast flank of Gales. Continuing indirect line prep on the south and southeast flanks.
6	Twentyfive Mile	WA-OWF	Sinclair	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Firing operations continue as fire behavior dictates.

7	Walker Creek/ Chickadee	WA-NES	Dimke	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Continuing direct and indirect line in combination with small firing operations.
8	Bulldog Mountain/Mack Mountain/ Summit Trail	WA-COF	Loomis	Continuing direct and indirect line in combination with small firing operations.
9	Cub Creek 2/ Muckamuck/ Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-NES	Goff	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Mopping up and securing lines on the north flank of Muckamuck. Implementing priority suppression repair.
10	Bull Complex	OR-MHF	Roide	Continuing firing operations on the south and northeast flanks. Continuing to work indirect control lines.
11	Lick Creek/Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Stock	Level 1 evacuations. Direct line construction on the southeast corner of Green Ridge.
12	Ford Corkscrew	WA-NES	Bernal	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations (planning to lift all evacuations on 8/30). Mopping up and securing lines on all flanks. TOC to local unit today at 1800 hrs.
