- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.
- Review and apply the Area Command recommendations as they fit the current/expected fire situation.

1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Twentyfive Mile	WA-OWF	Sinclair	Level 1 evacuations. Securing spots in the northwest corner. Continuing firing operations on the south flank.
3	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Dolan	Level 2 evacuations. Coordinating indirect options on the northeast corner of Smith with Rough Patch. Continue firing operations on Smith and Big Hamlin.
4	Schneider Springs	WA-OWF	Allen	Level 1 and 2 evacuations (dropped all level 3). Firing operations on the south flank along Bethel Ridge. Establishing indirect lines on the northeast corner above HWY 410.
5	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Goicoechea	Continuing firing operations on all fires. Establishing containment lines north and east of Chaos.

6	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Gales	Level 1 and 3 evacuations. Firing operations on the northeast flank of Gales. Continuing indirect line prep on the south and southeast flanks.
7	Bull Complex	OR-MHF	Roide	Level 1 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the northeast and southeast flanks as needed. Continuing to work indirect control lines.
8	Walker Creek/ Chickadee	WA-NES	Dimke	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Continuing direct and indirect line in combination with small firing operations.
9	Bulldog Mountain/Mack Mountain/ Summit Trail	WA-COF	Loomis	Continuing firing operations on Bulldog. Secure spots and implement firing operations on the north flank of Summit.
10	Cub Creek 2/ Muckamuck/ Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-NES	Goff	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Continuing firing operations and mop up on the northeast flank of Muckamuck. Implementing priority suppression repair.
11	Lick Creek/Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Stock	Level 1 evacuations. Patrolling and mopping up the north and west flanks of Green Ridge.
