Strategic Intent

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT 1/2 deployments. •
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed. •
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives. •
- Review and apply the Area Command recommendations as they fit the current/expected fire situation. •

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Goicoechea	Continue to secure north and south flanks of Chaos, continue to prep and establish indirect lines northeast of Chaos. Firing operations for Near Minky and Buckhead as conditions allow. Scout indirect lines east of Buckhead.
3	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Dolan	Level 2 evacuations. Improving indirect lines on the north and northeast corner of Smith. Continue firing operations on Smith and Big Hamlin.
4	Schneider Springs	WA-OWF	Allen	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Firing operations on the south flank along Bethel Ridge. Establishing indirect line on the northeast corner above HWY 410.
5	Bull Complex	OR-MHF	Roide	Level 1 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the northeast and southeast flanks as needed. Continuing to work indirect control lines. Structure protection for Bull of the Woods lookout.
6	Twentyfive Mile	WA-OWF	Sinclair	Level 1 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the northwest and south flanks. TOC to PNW Team 3 on 9/2 at 0600.

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
7	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Gales	Level 1 and 2 evacuations (dropped all level 3). Firing operations on the northeast flank of Gales. Securing spot fires on the south side of fire. Continuing indirect line prep on the south and southeast flanks.
8	Walker Creek/ Chickadee	WA-NES	Dimke	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Securing and mopping up on both fires. Strengthening all indirect lines on both fires.
9	Bulldog Mountain/Mack Mountain/ Summit Trail	WA-COF	Loomis	Continue direct and indirect line in combination with small firing operations. Bulldog and Mack Mountain TOC to local unit 9/2.
10	Cub Creek 2/ Muckamuck/ Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-NES	Goff	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Mopping up on the north flank of Muckamuck. Implementing priority suppression repair.
11	Lick Creek/Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Stock	Level 1 evacuations. Patrolling and mopping up the north and west flanks of Green Ridge. Continue direct line on southeast corner.
