- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT 1/2 deployments.
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.
- Review and apply the Area Command recommendations as they fit the current/expected fire situation.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	IC	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Goicoechea	Initiating firing operations along indirect line in northeast corner of Chaos. Continuing firing operations to connect Near Minky and Buckhead.
3	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Dolan	Level 2 evacuations. Improving indirect lines on the north and northeast corner of Smith. Continuing firing operations on Smith and Big Hamlin. Monitoring fire growth towards structures in Ash Creek Valley.
4	Bull Complex	OR-MHF	Roide	Level 1 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the northeast and southeast flanks as needed. Continuing to work indirect control lines. TOC 9/4 at 0600 to NR Team 4 (Connell).
5	Schneider Springs	WA-OWF	Allen	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the south flank along Bethel Ridge. Establishing indirect line on the northeast corner above HWY 410. Continuing firing operations along Bumping Lake Road.
6	Twentyfive Mile	WA-OWF	Johnson	Level 1 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the south flank.

<u>Priority</u>	Fire	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
7	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Gales	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the northeast flank of Gales. Securing spot fires on the south side of fire. TOC 9/4 at 0600 with NW Team 6 (Sheldon).
8	Summit Trail	WA-COF	Schwope	Continuing direct and indirect line in combination with small firing operations. Scouting direct line on northwest flank.
9	Walker Creek/ Chickadee	WA-NES	Dimke	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Securing and mopping up on both fires. Strengthening all indirect lines on both fires.
10	Cub Creek 2/ Muckamuck/ Cedar Creek/ Delancy	WA-NES	Goff	Mopping up on the north flank of Muckamuck. Implementing priority suppression repair.
11	Lick Creek/Green Ridge	OR-UMF	Stock	Level 1 evacuations. Patrolling and mopping up the northwest and southeast flanks of Green Ridge. TOC 9/4 at 0630 to SA Gray IMT3 (Ketron).
