## **Strategic Intent**

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT 1/2 deployments. •
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed. •
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives. •
- Review and apply the Area Command recommendations as they fit the current/expected fire situation. •

| 1               | Initial Attack                      |             |            | Initial attack is always the first priority.   |
| 2               | Rough Patch<br>Complex/Jack<br>Fire | OR-UPF      | Goicoechea | Continuing firing operations along indirect<br>line in northeast corner of Chaos. Continuing<br>firing operations on west side of Buckhead.  |
| 3               | Devils Knob<br>Complex              | OR-UPF      | Dallas     | Level 2 evacuations. Improving indirect lines<br>on the northeast corner of Smith. Continuing<br>firing operations on Smith and Big Hamlin.<br>Securing structures as fire enters Ash Creek<br>Valley.         |
| 4               | Schneider<br>Springs                | WA-OWF      | Allen      | Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Continuing firing<br>operations on the northeast corner above the<br>communities of Pinecliff and Cliffdale on<br>HWY 410. Continuing firing operations along<br>Bumping Lake Road. |
| 5               | Bull Complex                        | OR-MHF      | Connell    | Level 1 evacuations. Securing spots on east<br>flank. Continuing firing operations on the<br>south flank. Continuing to work indirect<br>control lines. Protecting Bull of the Woods<br>Lookout.               |
| 6               | Twentyfive<br>Mile                  | WA-OWF      | Johnson    | Level 1 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the northwest and south flanks.   |

| 7               | Middle Fork<br>Complex                                | OR-WIF      | Sheldon   | Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Continuing firing<br>operations on the southwest flanks of Gales.<br>Securing firing operations on northeast side of<br>fire. Scouting alternate indirect lines on<br>southeast side. |
| 8               | Summit Trail  | WA-COF      | Schwope   | Continuing direct and indirect line in<br>combination with small firing operations on<br>north and east flanks. Establishing indirect line<br>in wilderness.   |
| 9               | Walker Creek/<br>Chickadee                            | WA-NES      | Dimke     | Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Securing and<br>mopping up on both fires. Monitoring fire<br>growth on Walker Creek.  |
| 10              | Cub Creek 2/<br>Muckamuck/<br>Cedar Creek/<br>Delancy | WA-NES      | Goff      | Mopping and securing on Cub Creek and<br>Muckamuck. Implementing priority<br>suppression repair. TOC Cub/Cedar/Delancy<br>back to local unit on 9/7. TOC of Muckamuck<br>to IMT3 on 9/7.                         |
