- Provide support to Initial Attack and emerging incidents.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial mission requests, while providing incident staffing requirements for resources timing out on all large fires.

### PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

<b>Priority</b>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Dallas	Level 2 evacuations. Evaluating indirect lines on the northeast and east sides of Smith. Continuing firing operations on Smith and Big Hamlin. Securing structures as fire enters Ash Creek Valley.
3	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	Goicoechea	Continuing firing operations along indirect line in the northeast corner of Chaos. Continuing firing operations on west side of Buckhead.
4	Schneider Springs	WA-OWF	Allen	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the northeast corner above the communities of Pinecliff and Cliffdale on HWY 410. Continuing firing operations along Bumping Lake Road.
5	Bull Complex	OR-MHF	Connell	Level 1 evacuations. Securing spots on east flank. Continuing firing operations on the south flank. Continuing to work indirect control lines.

<b>Priority</b>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
6	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Sheldon	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the southwest and northeast flanks of Gales. Scouting alternate indirect lines on southeast side.
7	Twentyfive Mile	WA-OWF	Johnson	Level 1 evacuations. Continuing firing operations on the southwest indirect lines.
8	Summit Trail	WA-COF	Schwope	Continuing direct line on northeast flank. Firing indirect lines in and adjacent to the wilderness.
9	Walker Creek/ Chickadee	WA-NES	Dimke	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Securing and mopping up on both fires. Monitoring fire growth on the northwest side of Walker Creek. TOC Walker Creek to IMT3 on 9/8. TOC Chickadee to local unit on 9/8.
