Strategic Intent

- Provide support to Initial Attack and emerging incidents.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial mission requests, while providing incident staffing requirements for resources timing out on all large fires.
- Message and encourage the word about active fatigue management.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Cougar Peak	OR-FWF	Stock	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Significant fire growth.
3	Twentyfive Mile	WA-OWF	Johnson	Level 1 evacuations. Firing operations as conditions allow on south and west flanks.
4	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Dallas	Level 2 evacuations. Assuming operational control of Buckhead and Near Minky.
5	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	DeMasters	Working to contain spot fire around Quartz Mtn.
6	Schneider Springs	WA-OWF	Allen	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Fire crested American Ridge to the north, backing down to HWY 410.
7	Summit Trail	WA-COA	Schwoppe	Continuing with firing indirect lines in and adjacent to the wilderness.
8	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Sheldon	Level 2 evacuations. Continuing firing operations, as conditions allow, on the southwest and northeast flanks of Gales.
