Strategic Intent

- Provide support to Initial Attack and emerging incidents.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial mission requests, while providing incident staffing requirements for resources timing out on all large fires.
- Message and encourage the word about active fatigue management.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

|-----------------|-------------------------------------|-------------|-----------|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| 1 | Initial Attack | | | Initial attack is always the first priority. |
| 2 | Big Meadow | OR-BUD | Loomis | Meeting objectives towards containment. |
| 3 | Cougar Peak | OR-FWF | Stock | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Focus is southwest flank. |
| 4 | Schneider Springs | WA-OWF | Lawson | Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Direct and indirect line construction on north flank. |
| 5 | Devils Knob Complex | OR-UPF | Dallas | Level 3 evacuations. Improving and securing indirect control lines |
| 6 | Middle Fork Complex | OR-WIF | Sheldon | Level 2 evacuations. Mop-up and securing lines. |
| 7 | Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire | OR-UPF | DeMasters | Firing operations northeast corner of Chaos. |
