- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial mission requests, while providing incident staffing requirements for resources • timing out on all large fires.
- Message and encourage the word about active fatigue management. •

## **PNW Incident Priorities** (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Cougar Peak	OR-FWF	Stock	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Preparing east flank for expected weather.
3	Schneider Springs	WA-OWF	Lawson	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Working to secure the north flank.
4	Devils Knob Complex	OR-UPF	Dallas	Level 3 evacuations. Improving and securing indirect control lines. TOC to PNW Team 2 on 9/19/21 at 0600.
5	Rough Patch Complex/Jack Fire	OR-UPF	DeMasters	Securing spots on the northeast corner of Chaos and southeast flank of Buckhead.
6	Middle Fork Complex	OR-WIF	Sheldon	Level 2 evacuations. Securing lines and suppression repair.
7	Bull Complex	OR-MHF	Gales	Continuing to work indirect control lines.
