National Preparedness Level	Northwest Preparedness Level
3	4

Strategic Intent:

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT deployments.
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Rum Creek/Hog Creek	OR-MED	Gales	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuation notices remain. Active fire behavior. Improving anchor points. Building alternate fireline, going direct where possible. 16 OSFM Taskforce assigned for structure protection. Structure protection in place for the community of Galice.
3	White River/Irving Peak	WA-OWF	Stock	Level 1 and 2 evacuation notices remain. Active fire behavior on Irving Peak Fire. Scouting for other opportunities to merge the two incidents.
4	Crocketts Knob	OR-MAF	Dimke	Active fire behavior. Area closures in place. No evacuations. Finalizing strategic risk assessment and long-term plan.
5	Double Creek	OR-WWF	Lane	PNW 2 enroute. In-brief today at 1200.
6	Cedar Creek	OR-WIF	Sheldon	Prepping and establishing alternate fireline. Assessing direct strategy. Discussing MAP with Sherriff for campsites around Waldo Lake.
7	Windigo/Potter /Big Swamp	OR-UPF/ OR-WIF	Albrecht	Mop-up, patrol, backhaul, and suppression repair. No critical needs.
