- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT deployments. •
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed. ٠
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Double Creek/ Sturgill/Nebo/Goat Mountain Two	OR-WWF	Lane	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Structures and infrastructure threatened. Impacts to public and firefighter safety. Active point protection on two wilderness fires.
3	Boulder Mountain	WA-NES	Johnston	Level 3 evacuation in place. Threat to communication site on south flank. Day 1 of surge taskforce to attain incident objectives.
4	Cedar Creek	OR-WIF	Sheldon	Level 2 and 3 evacuations in place. Anticipated fire behavior will challenge suppression strategies. Alaska Team 1 in-brief at 0900 today.
5	Rum Creek	OR-MED	Winfield	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Structure protection in place. Firing operations continue to secure lines. Downsizing structure protection group. NR Team 6 joined unified command.
6	Crockets Knob	OR-MAF	Dimke	Level 1 evacuations and area closures in place. Active fire behavior on north flank.

8	Windigo/Potter/ Big Swamp	OR-UPF/ OR-WIF	Albrecht	Mop-up, patrol, backhaul, and suppression repair. No critical needs.
