#### **Strategic Intent:**

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT deployments.
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.

### PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

<b>Priority</b>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Double Creek/ Sturgill/Nebo/Goat Mountain Two	OR-WWF	Lane	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Structures and infrastructure threatened. Impacts to public and firefighter safety. Active point protection on two wilderness fires.
3	Cedar Creek	OR-WIF	Sheldon	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Anticipated fire behavior will challenge suppression strategies. Alaska Team 1 assumes command of the east zone at 0600 tomorrow.
4	Boulder Mountain	WA-NES	Johnston	Level 1 evacuations in place. Threat to communication site on south flank. Day 2 of surge taskforce to attain incident objectives.
5	Crockets Knob	OR-MAF	Dimke	Level 1 evacuations in place. Securing line on the north flank. Anticipate transition to T3 organization on Sunday.
6	Rum Creek	OR-MED	Winfield	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Securing line in the northwest corner to Rogue River.
7	Chilliwack/NW Pasayten	WA-NCP/ WA-OWF	Watts	Developing long-term strategies. Point protection in progress.
