Strategic Intent:

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT deployments.
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Cedar Creek	OR-WIF	Sheldon / McDonald	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Anticipated fire behavior will challenge suppression strategies. Alaska Team 1 assumes command of the east zone.
3	Double Creek/ Sturgill/Nebo/Goat Mountain Two	OR-WWF	Lane	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Structures and infrastructure threatened. Active point protection on two wilderness fires.
4	Van Meter	OR-LAD	McCarty	Level 2 and 3 evacuations in place. Structure protection in place. Working to secure south flank. ODF Team 3 assumes command.
5	Boulder Mountain	WA-NES	Johnston	Level 1 evacuations in place. Fire has reached communication site on south flank. Day 3 of surge taskforce to attain incident objectives.
6	Rum Creek	OR-MED	Winfield	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Securing line in the northwest corner to Rogue River.
7	Crockets Knob	OR-MAF	Dimke	Level 1 evacuations in place. Securing line on the north flank. TOC to T3 organization at 1800 Saturday.
