### Strategic Intent:

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT deployments.
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.

### PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

| 1               | Initial Attack                                      |                   |                    | Initial attack is always the first priority.   |
| 2               | Cedar Creek   | OR-WIF            | Sheldon / McDonald | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Substantial growth to the west. Evacuation of ICP. PNW 3 In-brief on 9/11.                 |
| 3               | Double Creek/<br>Sturgill/Nebo/Goat<br>Mountain Two | OR-WWF            | Lane               | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Structures and infrastructure threatened. Active point protection on two wilderness fires. |
| 4               | Van Meter   | OR-LAD            | McCarty            | Level 2 and 3 evacuations in place. Structure protection in place. Working to secure south flank.                                  |
| 5               | Boulder Mountain                                    | WA-NES            | Johnston           | Level 1 evacuations in place. Working to secure south flank around communication site.   |
| 6               | Rum Creek   | OR-MED            | Winfield           | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Securing line in the northwest corner to Rogue River.                                      |
| 7               | Crocketts Knob                                      | OR-MAF            | Dimke              | Level 1 evacuations in place. Securing line on the north flank. TOC to T3 organization at 1800 today.                              |
| 8               | Chilliwack/NW<br>Pasayten                           | WA-NCP/<br>WA-OWF | Watts              | Developing long-term strategies. Point protection in progress. Several fires merged within Chilliwack Complex.                     |
