Strategic Intent:

- Continue to support IA/emerging incidents and new IMT deployments.
- Keep existing incidents staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.
- Allocate critical resources to augment crucial missions and expedite incident objectives.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

Priority	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Cedar Creek	OR-WIF	Sheldon / McDonald	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Firing operations on west flank to create anchor points. East zone area of responsibility increased. PNW 3 in-brief at 1400.
3	Double Creek/ Sturgill/Nebo/Goat Mountain Two	OR-WWF	Lane	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Pulled ground resources from two wilderness fires to support spot fire west of Imnaha River.
4	Bolt Creek	WA-NWS	Stock	Level 3 evacuations in place. IMT2 in-brief today at 1800. Limited information received.
5	Goat Rocks	WA-GPF	Lawson	Level 2 and 3 evacuations in place. TOC to IMT2 today.
6	Boulder Mountain	WA-NES	Johnston	Level 1 evacuations in place. Working to secure west flank around communication site.
7	Van Meter	OR-LAD	McCarty	Level 2 evacuations in place. Reducing evacuation levels today. Mopping up and securing lines.
8	Rum Creek	OR-MED	Winfield	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations in place. Lines holding, containment increasing.
