## **Strategic Intent:**

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Continue to supply existing incidents with resources that meet their most critical needs, per our prioritization process.
- Work with Agencies/IMT's to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.
- Utilize surge resources for critical missions that maximizes opportunities to safely meet incident objectives.

## **PNW Incident Priorities** (*set daily*):

| 1               | Initial Attack |             |           | Initial attack is always the first priority.   |
| 2               | Gray           | WA-NES      | LeFevre   | Level 3 evacuations. 185 structures lost. I-90<br>closed near Spokane, WA. Six WA State<br>Taskforces mobilized.                 |
| 3               | Oregon Road    | WA-NES      | Quinones  | Level 3 evacuations. Power and infrastructure threatened. Structure assessments on-going. TOC to PNW3 8/22.                      |
| 4               | Lookout        | OR-WIF      | Albrecht  | Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Unified command<br>with OSFM. Portion of Highway 242 closed,<br>potential closure of Highway 126. |
| 5               | Bedrock        | OR-WIF      | Loomis    | Level 1, 2 and 3 evacuations in place. Direct and indirect attack on west flank. Mop-up and secure north, east and south flanks. |

| 6               | Sourdough   | WA-NCP      | Stock     | Level 1 and 2 evacuations. SR 20 has closed sections. Safety concerns due to rollout. Continue to support Blue Lake and Huckleberry Flats. |
| 7               | Flat        | OR-RSF      | Elmore    | Minimal fire behavior. Providing support to OR/CA border incidents.  |
