### Strategic Intent:

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Utilize surge resources for critical missions that maximizes opportunities to safely meet incident objectives.
- Keep existing incidents adequately staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.

### PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Oregon Road	WA-NES	Quinones	Level 3 evacuations. Lowered evacuations from Level 3 to Level 2 in some areas. Power and infrastructure threatened. Structure assessments on-going.
3	Lookout	OR-WIF	Albrecht	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Portion of Highway 242 closed, potential closure of Highway 126. TOC to PNW2 on 8/26 at 1800.
4	Bedrock	OR-WIF	Loomis	Level 1 and 2 evacuations; one property in Level 3. Finishing firing operations on NW flank. Mop-up and secure north, east, and south flanks.
5	Gray	WA-NES	LeFevre	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. All Level 3 dropped. Power restored in fire area. Staggered release of state mob resources.
6	Sourdough	WA-NCP	Stock	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Patrol SR 20 to mitigate hazards in coordination with WSDOT.
