Strategic Intent:

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Utilize surge resources for critical missions that maximizes opportunities to safely meet incident objectives and to augment local unit initial attack resources where needed.
- Keep existing incidents adequately staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

Priority	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Lookout	OR-WIF	Albrecht	Level 1, 2, and 3 evacuations. Portion of Highway 242 closed, potential closure of Highway 126. TOC to PNW2 on 8/26 at 1800.
3	Oregon Road	WA-NES	Lewis	Level 1 and 3 evacuations. Structure assessments on-going. Beginning limited demob today.
4	Bedrock	OR-WIF	Loomis	Level 1 and 2 evacuations; one property in Level 3. Mop-up and secure north, east, and south flanks. Supported new start near Diamond Lake.
5	Gray	WA-NES	LeFevre	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Staggered release of state mob resources. Securing lines around residences.
6	Sourdough	WA-NCP	Stock	Level 1 and 2 evacuations. Patrol SR 20 to mitigate hazards in coordination with WSDOT. Increase fire activity on the north flank.
