## **Strategic Intent:**

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Prioritize critical missions that maximize opportunities to safely meet incident objectives and to augment local unit initial attack resources where needed.
- Keep existing incidents adequately staffed by replacing timed out resources as needed.

## PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

<b>Priority</b>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Anvil	OR-RSF	Shaw	Level 2 and 3 evacuations in place. Active fire behavior. Red Flag conditions forecasted.
3	Camp Creek	OR-MHF	Click	Protecting resources and infrastructure within the Bull Run municipal watershed. Reviewing complexity analysis and turn back standards.
4	Lookout	OR-WIF	Loomis	Level 1 and 2 evacuations in place. Incident includes Horse Creek and Pothole. Providing support to Petes Lake.
5	Chilcoot	OR-UPF	Albrecht	Area closures in place. Active fire behavior. Planning firing operations.
6	Brice Creek/ Grizzly	OR-UPF	Albrecht	Level 2 evacuations in place for Bohemia mining community. Increased fire activity. On Grizzly, MAP reached on south flank and continuing point protection.
7	Cowlitz Complex	WA-GPF	Wakoski	Road and trail closures in place. Increased fire activity. Primary fires within the complex are Spencer Quartz, Snagtooth, and Grassy Mountain.

10	Bedrock	OR-WIF	Loomis	Continuing suppression repair and backhaul.
11	Ridge	OR-UPF	Albrecht	Continuing mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair.
12	Dinner	OR-UPF	Albrecht	Continuing mop-up and patrol.
