CIMT NW Team 13 in briefing today at 1600.
	0404 RV Lone Rock	OR-PRD	Loomis	Evacuations and closures in place. Critical needs: Aircraft, 1-CRW1, 6-TFLD, 6-DOZ, 4-DIVS, T3 helo with crew, 1-AOBD, 11-WT. CIMT PNW Team 2 TOC 7/17.
2	Falls/Upper Pine	OR-MAF	Stock	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Moderate to high probability of success. Hwy 395 open with pilot car. Critical needs: Airtankers, Lead Plane, 1-T1 helo, 1-T2 helo, Air Attack, TFLD, HEQB, EDSD, EDSP, INBA, BUYT or members, Dozers, Graders, Water Tenders.
3	Pioneer	WA-SES	Dimke	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Community of Stehekin threatened. Critical needs: 1-T3 exc use helo with crew.
4	Larch Creek	OR-954S	Howard	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Continue securing line and gaining depth on mop-up. No critical needs at this time.
