Strategic Intent

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMT's to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.
- Planning and making deliberate decisions on limited replacement or reallocation of shared resources from NMAC.

| 4 | Durkee/Cow Valley/Bonita Road | OR-VAD | Albrecht | Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to community of Dale. Primary focus is Monkey Creek fire. |
| 5 | Battle Mountain Complex | OR-973S | McCarty | Level 2 evacuations. Microwave Tower fire primary focus with threat to Mosier. |

| 8 | Swawilla 1/Bridge Creek | WA-COA | Cowger | Level 2 evacuations. Threats to residence, infrastructure and Tribal natural resource values. |
| 9 | Diamond Complex | OR-UPF | LeFevre | Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to utility infrastructure. Twenty-three fires in complex. |
| 10 | Cougar Creek | WA-SES | Gales | Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Primary focus north half. Reducing threats to communities of Anatone, Grouse Flats and Troy. |
| 11 | Cottage Grove Complex | OR-771S | Cheek | Level 1 evacuation. Evaluating fires in complex. |
| 12 | Pioneer/Easy | WA-SES | Click | Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Community of Stehekin threatened. Primary focus north line. Easy fire, highway 20 closure in affect. |
| 13 | Pyramid | OR-WIF | Mueller | Primary focus keeping fire north of private timber. |
| 14 | Homestead Complex | OR-UPF | Ingram | Evaluating fires in the complex. |
| 15 | Ore | OR-WIF | Orr | Continued road prep for indirect line. |
| 16 | Chalk/Moss Mountain | OR-WIF | Dallas | Level 1 evacuation. Priority fire is Chalk. |
