Strategic Intent

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMT's to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.
- Planning and making deliberate decisions on limited replacement or reallocation of shared resources from NMAC.

2	Swawilla 1/Bridge Creek	WA-COA	Cowger	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to residence, infrastructure and Tribal natural resource values. Threats to communities of Keller, Blue Lake, Buffalo Lake.
3	Durkee/Cow Valley/Bonita Road	OR-VAD	Albrecht	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Communities and infrastructure at risk. Primary focus on the northwest line.
4	Falls/Telephone/Ritter	OR-MAF	McDonald	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats communities and infrastructure.
5	Retreat	WA-SES	Olson	Level 3 evacuations. Threats to community of Yakima.
6	Battle Mountain Complex/Courtrock	OR-973S	Hessel/ McCarty	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to community of Dale.
7	Badlands Complex	OR-VAD	Hohn	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to community of Durkee and infrastructure.
8	0404 RV Lone Rock	OR-PRD	Loomis	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Evaluating resource needs.

10	Microwave Tower/Whisky Creek	OR-954S	McFarland	Level 3 and 1 evacuations. Microwave Tower fire primary focus with threat to Mosier.
11	Diamond Complex	OR-UPF	LeFevre	Level 3 and 2 evacuations. Threats to utility infrastructure.
12	Pyramid/Slate	OR-WIF	Mueller	Primary focus keeping fire north of private timber on Pyramid. Reducing threat to community of Detroit for Slate.
13	Cougar Creek	WA-SES	Gales	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Primary focus north half. Reducing threats to communities of Anatone, Grouse Flats and Troy.
14	Chalk/Moss Mtn.	OR-WIF	Dallas	Level 1 evacuation. Primary focus Moss Mtn., Coffee Pot.
15	Crazy Creek	OR-OCF	Gesser	Level 3 and 1 evacuations. Assessing and engaging incidents.
16	Homestead Complex	OR-UPF	Ingram	Engaging fires in the complex. Assessing and engaging incidents of complex.
17	Cottage Grove	OR-771S	Cheek	Level 1 evacuations
18	Red/Wickiup/Jackpine	OR-DEF	Jenkins	Level 1 evacuations. Assessing incidents.
19	Ore	OR-WIF	Orr	Continued road prep for indirect line.
