Strategic Intent

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMTs to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.
- Work with partner agencies to ensure requested incident management organization is commensurate with complexity.
- Planning and making deliberate decisions on limited replacement or reallocation of shared resources from NMAC.

1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Falls/Telephone/Ritter	OR-MAF	McDonald	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to communities and infrastructure.
3	Crazy Creek	OR-OCF	Gessler	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to community of Paulina.
4	Pioneer/Easy	WA-SES	Click	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Community of Stehekin threatened. Primary focus north line. Prepping Highway 20.
5	Diamond Complex/Middle Fork	OR-UPF	LeFevre	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to utility infrastructure.
6	Retreat	WA-SES	Olson	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to communities of Yakima River Valley.
7	Cottage Grove	OR-771S	Cheek	Level 2 evacuations of Bohemia Mine.

8	Willamette Complex	OR-WIF	Dallas	Level 1 evacuations. Complex consists of Chalk, Moss Mtn., Coffee Pot, Ore, 208, 217, McKinley and Tire Mtn.
9	Homestead Complex	OR-UPF	Ingram	Engaging fires in the complex. Protecting timber values on private land.
10	Swawilla 1/Bridge Creek	WA-COA	Cowger	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to residence, infrastructure and Tribal natural resource values.
11	Winding Waters	OR-974S	Howard	Four of five fires looking good. Primary focus is Big Canyon. Potential TOC next week.
12	Cougar Creek	WA-SES	Dimke	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Primary focus north half. Reducing threats to communities of Anatone, Grouse Flats and Troy.
13	Pyramid/Slate	OR-WIF	Mueller	Level 3 evacuations. Meeting incident objectives. Primary focus keeping fire north of private timber on Pyramid.
14	Battle Mountain Complex/Courtrock	OR-973S	Hessel/McCarty	Reduced evacuation notices. Threats to community of Dale. No significant growth.
15	Microwave Tower/Whisky Creek	OR-954S	Goers	Level 3 and 1 evacuations. Whiskey Creek Fire primary focus.
16	Red/Round Mtn.	OR-DEF	Jenkins	Reduced evacuation notices.
17	Badland Complex	OR-VAD	Hohn	Evacuation notices. Threats to community of Durkee and infrastructure.
18	0404 RV Lone Rock	OR-PRD	Truett	Level 2 and 1 evacuations. Right-sizing organization..
19	Durkee/Cow Valley	OR-VAD	Beard	Reduced evacuation notices. Right-sizing organization.
