Strategic Intent

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMTs to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.
- Work with partner agencies to ensure requested incident management organization is commensurate with complexity.
- Planning and making deliberate decisions on limited replacement or reallocation of shared resources from NMAC.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Pioneer/Easy	WA-SES	Clemo	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Community of Stehekin threatened. Primary focus north line. Closure of Highway 20. Flat Creek Fire added to the delegation.
3	Falls/Telephone/Ritter	OR-MAF	McDonald	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to communities and infrastructure.
4	Crazy Creek	OR-OCF	Gessler	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to community of Paulina and private land.
5	Diamond Complex/Middle Fork	OR-UPF	Behrens	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to utility infrastructure and access to Crater Lake via Highway 230.
6	Cottage Grove	OR-771S	Cheek	Level 2 and 1 evacuations of Bohemia Mine.

7	Willamette Complex	OR-WIF	Dallas	Level 1 evacuations. Complex consists of Chalk, Moss Mtn., Coffee Pot, Ore, 208, 217, McKinley, Tire Mtn, Pyramid and Slate.
8	Retreat	WA-SES	Olson	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to Highway 12 and private residences.
9	Homestead Complex	OR-UPF	Ingram	Engaging fires in the complex and protecting timber values on private land.
10	Microwave Tower/Whiskey Creek	OR-954S	Schuster	Level 3 and 1 evacuations. Whiskey Creek Fire primary focus.
11	Cougar Creek	WA-SES	Dimke	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Primary focus north half. Reducing threats to communities of Anatone, Grouse Flats and Troy.
12	Red/Round Mtn.	OR-DEF	Jenkins	Reduced evacuation notices. Conducting structure assessment. TOC on 8/8 to Type 3 team.
13	Battle Mountain Complex	OR-973S	McCarty	Reduction in some evacuation notices. Threats to community of Dale. No significant growth.
14	0404 RV Lone Rock/Courtrock	OR-PRD	Truett	Evaluating evacuation levels. Good progress, no needs. Assisting with initial attack.
15	Swawilla 1	WA-COA	Patterson	Level 2 and 1 evacuations. Reducing threats to residences, infrastructure and Tribal natural resource values.
16	Durkee/Cow Valley	OR-VAD	Beard	Reduced evacuation notices. Right-sizing organization. TOC to local unit on 8/7.
