Strategic Intent

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMTs to adjust strategy and tactics to align with existing resources and the likelihood of few additional resources coming into the Geographic Area.
- Work with partner agencies to ensure requested incident management organization is commensurate with complexity.
- Planning and making deliberate decisions on limited replacement or reallocation of shared resources from NMAC.

1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
	Town Gulch	OR-WWF		Emerging incident, IMT3/OSFM Blue Team unified command. CIMT SA #2 is mobilizing today.
	Williams Mine	WA-GPF		Emerging incident, CIMT NW Team 13 is mobilizing today.
	Warner Peak	OR-SHR		Emerging incident, ICT3.
2	Pioneer/Easy	WA-SES	Clemo	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Community of Stehekin threatened. Primary focus is on the northern line. Closure of Highway 20.
3	Diamond Complex/Middle Fork	OR-UPF	Behrens	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to utility infrastructure and access to Crater Lake via Highway 230.
4	Willamette Complex North	OR-WIF	Boehm	Level 3 and 1 evacuations. North Zone: Ore, Pyramid and Slate fires.

5	Crazy Creek	OR-OCF	Gessler	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to private land and historical sites. Close to meeting containment objectives on the NE side.
6	Cottage Grove	OR-771S	Cheek	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuation notices around Bohemia Mining District.
7	Cougar Creek	WA-SES	Dimke	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Primary focus is on the west line. Intend a transition to IMT3.
8	Willamette Complex South	OR-WIF	Dallas	Level 1 evacuations. South Zone: 208, 217, Chalk Mountain, Coffeepot, McKinley, Miss Mountain and Tire fires.
9	Retreat	WA-SES	Snow	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Threats to Highway 12 and private residences.
10	Whisky Creek/Sandstone	OR-954S	Schuster	Threats to infrastructure and private lands.
11	Homestead Complex	OR-UPF	Stock	Protecting timber values. No Man Fire is the priority.
12	Falls/Telephone/Ritter	OR-MAF	McDonald	Level 3, 2, 1 evacuations. Some evacuation levels reduced. Threats to communities and infrastructure. Focus is on the Sand Fire.
13	Battle Mountain Complex	OR-973S	Rau	Reduction in some evacuation notices across the fire perimeter. No significant growth.
14	0404 RV Lone Rock/Courtrock	OR-PRD	Truett	Level 2 and 1 evacuation notices. Good progress, no needs. Assisting with initial attack.
