Strategic Intent

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMTs to develop strategy and tactics considering span of control, limited resource availability, and cumulative fatigue.
- Implement strategic resource placement commensurate with predicted fuels and fire weather conditions.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

Priority	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1.	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2.	Diamond Complex/ Middle Fork	OR-UPF	Opliger	North entrance to Crater Lake National Park closed.
3.	Homestead Complex	OR-UPF	Pyrah	Area closures in place. Protecting timber values.
4.	Willamette Complex North	OR-WIF	Orr	Area closures in place. Ore is the priority fire.
5.	Willamette Complex South	OR-WIF	Jenkins	Area closures in place. Moss Mountain is the priority fire.
6.	Whisky Creek/ Sandstone	OR-MHF	North	Long-term threats to infrastructure and private lands.
7.	Williams Mine	WA-GPF	Gales	Tribal timber and cultural values threatened. TOC to IMT3 today at 1800.
8.	Lane 1	OR-771S	McDonald	Level 3 evacuations around Bohemia Mining District.
9.	Pioneer	WA-SES	Click	Level 1 evacuation notices. North zone to IMT3 and south zone T4 organization tomorrow at 1700.
