Strategic Intent

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMTs to develop strategy and tactics considering span of control, limited resource availability, and cumulative fatigue.
- Implement strategic resource placement commensurate with predicted fuels and fire weather conditions.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

1.	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
	Copperfield	OR-981S		<i>Emerging Incident</i> . OSFM Red Team and ODF Team 3 inbriefing at 1000. Level 3 evacuations in place. A portion of Sprague River Highway is closed.
2.	Diamond Complex/ Middle Fork	OR-UPF	Beard	The North Entrance Road to Crater Lake National Park will remain open through today. Portions of the Pacific Crest Trail are closed. Mitigating threats to transmission lines and recreation infrastructure.
3.	Willamette Complex South	OR-WIF	Jenkins	Working to confine fire spread. Protecting communities, transportation and communication infrastructure, cultural sites, and timber values.
4.	Homestead Complex	OR-UPF	Stock	Protecting communication infrastructure, Bohemia Mining District, timber values, and critical fish habitat.
5.	Willamette Complex North	OR-WIF	Orr	Protecting transportation and communication infrastructure, cultural sites, and timber values. TOC to CIMT CA Team 13 tomorrow at 0700.
6.	Whisky Creek/ Sandstone	OR-MHF	Dimke	Mitigating threats to transportation and recreation infrastructure and private lands. A section of the Pacific Crest Trail is closed.
7.	Lane 1	OR-771S	McDonald	Level 3 evacuations around Bohemia Mining District. Managing suppression repair to reduce impacts to communities.
