### Strategic Intent

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMTs to develop strategy and tactics considering span of control, limited resource availability, and cumulative fatigue.
- Implement strategic resource placement commensurate with predicted fuels and fire weather conditions.

<b>1.</b>	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
	Shoe Fly	OR-953S		Emerging Incident. ODF Team 1 TOC today at 1800.
	Rail Ridge	OR-PRD		Emerging Incident. CIMT on order.
<b>2.</b>	Copperfield	OR-981S	McCarty	ODF Team 3 in Unified Command with OSFM Red Team. Level 3 evacuations and road closures in place.
<b>3.</b>	Diamond Complex/ Middle Fork	OR-UPF	Beard	The North Entrance Road to Crater Lake National Park and portions of the Pacific Crest Trail are closed. Mitigating threats to transmission lines and recreation infrastructure.
<b>4.</b>	Homestead Complex	OR-UPF	Stock	Protecting communication infrastructure, Bohemia Mining District, timber values, and critical fish habitat.
<b>5.</b>	Willamette Complex North	OR-WIF	Boehm	Protecting H.J. Andrews Experimental Forest, transportation and communication infrastructure, cultural sites, and timber values.
<b>6.</b>	Willamette Complex South	OR-WIF	Jenkins	Working to confine fire spread. Protecting communities, transportation and communication infrastructure, cultural sites, and timber values.
<b>7.</b>	Whisky Creek/ Sandstone	OR-MHF	Dimke	Mitigating threats to transportation and recreation infrastructure and private lands. A section of the Pacific Crest Trail is closed.
<b>8.</b>	Lane 1	OR-771S	McDonald	Level 3 evacuations around Bohemia Mining District. Managing suppression repair to reduce impacts to communities.
