### **Strategic Intent**

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMTs to develop strategy and tactics considering span of control, limited resource availability, and cumulative fatigue.
- Implement strategic resource placement commensurate with predicted fuels and fire weather conditions.

1.	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
	Wiley Flat	OR-OCF		Emerging Incident. CIMT CA Team 1 is mobilizing.
2.	Shoe Fly/Two Cabin	OR-953S	Hessel	Level 1 and 2 notices and Level 3 evacuations are in place. Threats to critical communication infrastructure.
3.	Rail Ridge	OR-PRD	Mack	Assessing evacuation levels. Protecting critical communication infrastructure.
4.	Willamette Complex North	OR-WIF	Boehm	Threats to H.J. Andrews Experimental Forest, transportation and communication infrastructure, cultural sites, and timber values.
5.	Copperfield	OR-981S	McCarty	Level 1 and 2 notices and Level 3 evacuations are in place. Threats to Tribal and cultural values.
6.	Willamette Complex South	OR-WIF	Szulc	Threats to transportation and communication infrastructure, cultural sites, and timber values.
7.	Diamond Complex/ Middle Fork	OR-UPF	Beard	The North Entrance Road to Crater Lake National Park and portions of the Pacific Crest Trail are closed.  Mitigating threats to transmission lines and recreation infrastructure.
8.	Homestead Complex	OR-UPF	Stock	Threats to communication infrastructure, Bohemia Mining District, timber values, and critical fish habitat.
9.	Whisky Creek/ Sandstone	OR-MHF	Dimke	Threats to transportation and recreation infrastructure and private lands.
