#### **Strategic Intent**

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Utilize resources for suppression repair work only associated with critical values at risk that are directly tied to life safety and infrastructure.
- Work with Agencies/IMTs to develop strategy and tactics considering span of control, limited resource availability, and cumulative fatigue.
- Implement strategic resource placement commensurate with predicted fuels and fire weather conditions.

1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Bachelor Complex	OR-DEF	Click	Level 1 notices and level 3 evacuations in effect. Threats to critical infrastructure.
3	Rail Ridge	OR-PRD	Mack	Level 3 evacuations in effect. Threats to critical communication infrastructure.
4	Willamette Complex North	OR-WIF	Boehm	Level 1 notices and level 3 evacuations in effect. Highway 242 closed. Threats to transportation and communication infrastructure, cultural sites, and timber values. TOC to NR Team 6 tomorrow at 0700.
5	Devils Knob	OR-UPF	Gales	Level 1 notices in effect. Threats to cultural and natural resources.
6	Fossil Complex	OR-953S	Howard	Level 3 evacuations in effect. Threats to transmission lines and communication infrastructure.
7	Buck Creek	OR-FWF	North	Threats to natural resources and cultural sites.
8	Willamette Complex South	OR-WIF	Szulc	Level 1 notices in effect. Threats to transportation and communication infrastructure, cultural sites, and timber values.
9	Wiley Flat	OR-OCF	Goss	Level 3 evacuations in effect. Highway 380 closed.
