Strategic Intent

- Continue to support initial attack, emerging incidents, and new IMT deployments.
- Work with Agencies/IMTs to develop strategy and tactics considering span of control, resource availability, suppression repair, and cumulative fatigue.
- Implement strategic resource placement commensurate with predicted fuels and fire weather conditions.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

Priority	Fire	Unit	IC	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Rail Ridge/ Wiley Flat	OR-WIF	Livingston	Level 2 notices on both fires and level 3 evacuations for Wiley Flat in effect. Constructing and strengthening control lines.
3	Willamette Complex South	OR-PRD	Jenkins	Level 1 notices in effect for Red Fire. Strengthening control lines and continuing suppression repair.
4	Willamette Complex North	OR-WIF	Cowger	Level 1 notices in effect. Strengthening control lines, mopping up, and continuing suppression repair.
5	Homestead Complex	OR-UPF	LeFevre	Strengthening control lines. Mitigating threats to Bohemia Mining District and timber values. Preparing for TOC with NW Team 12 on 9/26 at 1800.
6	Diamond Complex	OR-FWF	Gould	Continuing suppression repair, mop up, and right sizing to prepare for TOC with NW Team 12 on 9/26 at 1800.
7	Buck Creek	OR-UPF	North	Strengthening control lines and mopping up. Planning for TOC to T4 organization on 9/27 at 0600.
8	Fossil Complex	OR-953S	McCarty	Continuing suppression repair, mop up, and right sizing the organization.
