Strategic Intent

- Continue to prioritize initial attack and support emerging incidents and new IMT deployments.
- Implement strategic resource placement commensurate with incident priorities, predicted fuels, and fire weather conditions.
- Maintain staffing on fires to meet incident objectives.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

Priority	Fire	Unit	IC	Rationale
1	Initial Attack Kelsey Peak	OR-MED	Quinones	Initial attack is always the first priority. Not in priority order. Emerging incident. CIMT ODF Team 1. Transfer of command 9/8.
2	Crown Creek/ Katy Creek	WA-NES	Dimke	Level 3, 2, and 1 evacuations are in effect. Structure loss with ongoing damage assessment. Natural and timber resources threatened.
3	Lower Sugarloaf/ Labor Mountain	WA-OWF	Osborne	Level 3, 2, and 1 evacuations are in effect. Critical power infrastructure threatened.
4	Rattlesnake/ Lynx Mountain	WA-COA	LeFevre	Level 3, 2, and 1 evacuations are in effect. Road, trail, and area closures. Timber and Tribal values threatened.
5	Moon Complex	OR-RSF	Ingram	Complex includes four incidents with limited access and challenging terrain. Closures in effect. Assessing evacuation levels. Historic and recreation values threatened.

Priority	Fire	Unit	IC	Rationale
6	Wildcat	WA-OWF	North	Level 2 evacuations are in effect. Road, trail, and area closures. Historical properties threatened.
7	Bridge	OR-MAF	Oplinger	Level 1 evacuations are in effect. Road, trail, and area closures. Power infrastructure threatened.
8	Emigrant	OR-WIF	Gales	Road, trail, and area closures. Natural and timber resources, and hydroelectric infrastructure threatened. CIMT CA Team 3 in briefing at 1500 on 9/7.
9	Tacoma Creek	WA-NES	Johnston	CIMT GB Team 7 assumed command at 0600 on 9/7. Closures in place. Wildlife refuge, timber, and power infrastructure threatened.
10	Marks Creek	OR-OCF	Howard	Reduced evacuation levels to 2 and 1.
